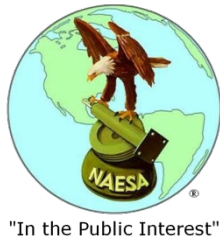

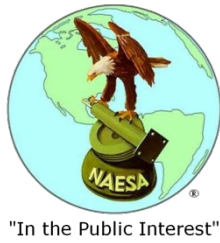
Brian Rausch, State of Wisconsin

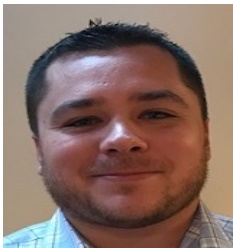

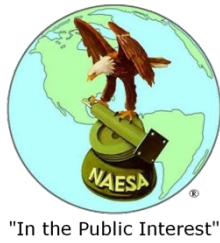

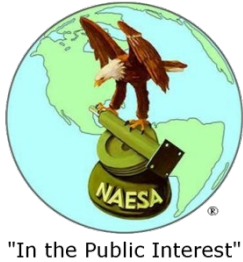
