Overview/ Synopsis: The five-hour training course is interactive and intended to teach much of the newer code material found in;

- 1) **The latest edition, what's in it for us? @ 0.025 hour**
 - a. Many of us wrestle with the thought of learning another code, especially when the AHJ has not adopted the latest edition! It's a lot to learn and even more to decipher as we all go through our daily routines.
 - b. This class will address why and attempt to help us understand the meaning of "knowing" the latest edition of codes and guides.
 - c. We will apply the focus of "knowing" throughout the day as we progress with each update class.
- 2) **2020 Elevator Industry Field Employee Safety Handbook @ 1 hour**
 - a. We will cover what is new and revised in the EIFESH.
 - b. We will have a few practice scenarios as well, so please bring your book to class
- 3) **ASME A17.5-2019 @ 2 hours**
 - a. This A17.5 class is a code update, and we will review the new and revised portions of this code as it pertains to the elevator inspector and mechanic. As part of the review, we will examine ASME A17.2 Nonmandatory Appendix C.
 - b. This class is also an "Awareness" class. QEI outlines that we are to have knowledge and awareness of A17.5. We will be reviewing the portions of A17.5 that will bring about this awareness and where you, the inspector, and the mechanic apply your skill and capabilities. A17.1 and A18.1 will be part of this presentation.
 - c. It will help you a lot if you can bring this book to class.
- 4) **NFPA 70-2020 @ 1.75 hours**
 - a. Primarily this class will focus on what is new/revised in NEC. A secondary objective is reviewing portions of articles 110 electrical installations, 300 wiring methods, 400 Flexible cords and cables, Article 620 and 701 Standby power systems. We may have scenarios at the end, time permitting. Please bring your NEC.
